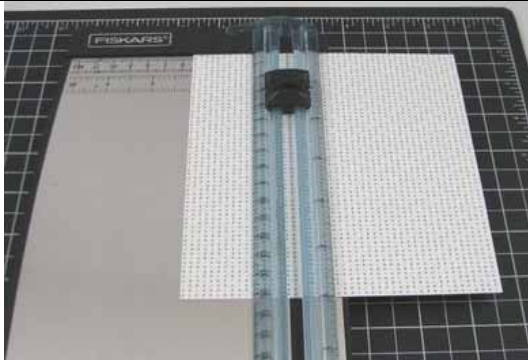

Supplies

Paper Cutter with Scoring Blade
6 x 6 inch piece of Designer Series Paper
1 x 8 inch piece of coordinating cardstock
Scrap in Whisper White & Pumpkin Pie
Pumpkin Pie & So Saffron Classic Ink
White StazOn
Tart'n'Tangy Stamp Set
Pretty Petals Background Stamp
Silver Brads
Whisper White Ribbon
Punches: Scallop, 1 3/8" Circle, 1/16" Circle
Scissors (not shown)
Adhesive (not shown)
Medium Cello Bags

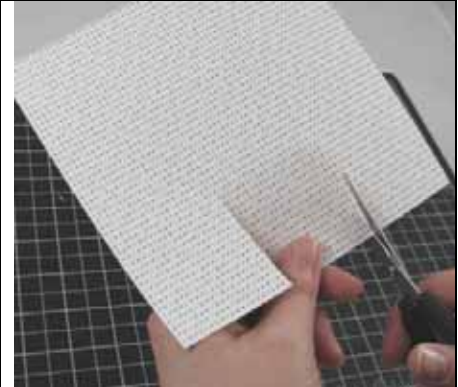


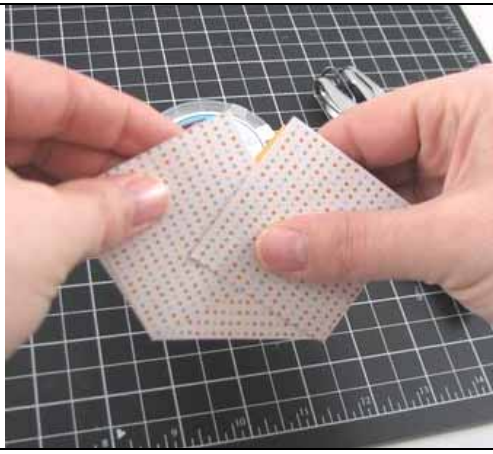
Step 1

Cut a piece of Designer Paper to 6 by 6 inches. Score at 2 and 4 inches. Turn paper 90 degrees and score again at 2 and 4

Step 2

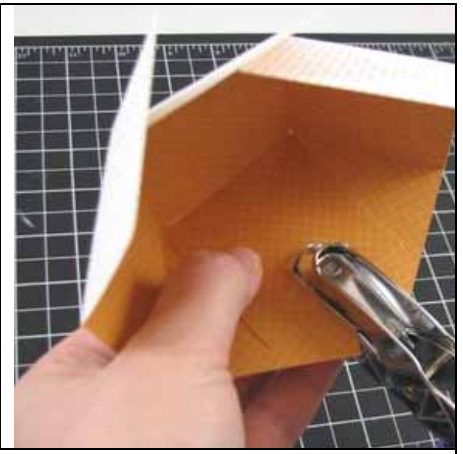
Cut along the scored lines at 2 and 4 inches. Flip 180 degrees and cut the other at 2 and 4.





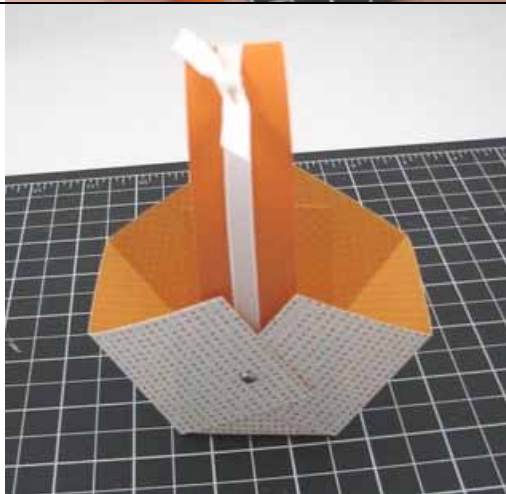
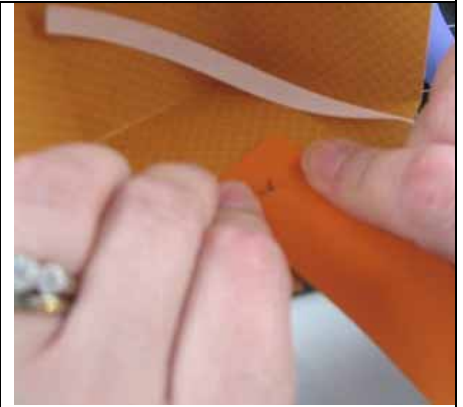
Step 3
Fold along the score lines. Pull the two edges so they overlap and cover the middle square.

Step 4
Using the 1/16 inch hand held circle punch, pierce a hole going through all three squares. You can place a bit of adhesive here if you like to hold until you are ready to put your brad through.



Step 5
Pierce a hole through the ribbon & handle (piece of CS measured 1 by 8 inches). Repeat at both ends.

Step 6
Line up the ribbon and handle with the DS paper and place a silver brad through all pieces. Repeat for the other side.



Step 7
Finish off with a bow and you have your basket. Now it is time to decorate the outside and fill the inside!

Step 8
Stamp the orange from Tart'n'Tangy in So Saffron Classic Ink.



Step 9
Before stamping the image on the cardstock, roll the edges in Pumpkin Pie Classic Ink

Step 10
Stamp the image onto Whisper White scrap paper.

Tip: when using the rock'n'roll technique, always stamp in the light colour first.





Step 11
Punch the orange out using the 1 3/8 inch circle and adhere to a Pumpkin Pie Scallop. Adhere to the basket covering the brad.



Step 12
Using White StazOn, ink the Pretty Petals Background stamp.



Step 13
Stamp the image onto a clear cello bag.

Note: StazOn Ink is great for plastic, ceramic and watercoloring as it is a solvent based ink and is made to be permanent!

Step 14
Fill the bag with candy and put in your basket, a lovely hostess gift and great display.
